- Participate in a recorded oral history interview (in person, by phone or video call)
- Share photographs, letters or other personal materials for possible inclusion in the book
- Review and approve your interview transcript before it is used
- Be acknowledged in the publication by name, or anonymously if you prefer

Your Rights as a Participant

Please read the following carefully. Your participation is entirely voluntary.

- You may withdraw your consent at any time, for any reason, without consequence. Simply contact Erin Jackson at waggagirlsbook@gmail.com or 0421 273 050.
- If you withdraw, any recordings or materials you have provided will be deleted or returned to you on request, unless the material has already been incorporated into a published work.
- You are welcome and encouraged to have a support person present during any interview or interaction related to this project.
- You will be provided with a copy of your interview transcript to review. You may request changes, additions or deletions before giving final approval for your story to be used.
- You may choose to be identified by your full name, first name only, or anonymously.
- You may decline to answer any question during an interview without giving a reason.
- Participation will not involve any financial payment.

How Your Information Will Be Stored

- All interview recordings and transcripts will be stored securely and accessed only by Erin Jackson and any approved transcription service.

- Digital files will be password protected. Physical materials will be stored securely.
- Recordings and transcripts may be offered for deposit with a local heritage institution (such as the CSU Regional Archives or Museum of the Riverina) at the conclusion of the project. You will be consulted before any such deposit is made.
- Your personal contact details will never be shared with third parties.
